The Fellow will have the opportunity to be directly involved in the initial assessment of these disorders as well as their management, both surgical and non-surgical and the ongoing care of these patients.</p> <p>Arthroplasty of the knee is robotic for primary replacements and computer navigated for revision arthroplasties. Hip Arthroplasty is the minimal invasive anterior approach. The Fellow will also have exposure in the assessment and treatment of injuries and trauma that present to fracture clinic.</p> <p>This experience will take place in a supervised environment to optimise the potential for learning and is associated with preparation of clinical research for presentation and publication.</p>
